



ARTURO PANI GILT BRASS CIRCULAR COCKTAIL TABLE

An exceptional Arturo Pani gilt brass circular cocktail table made in Mexico City, circa 1950s. This finely detailed design exemplifies Pani's distinctive interpretation of Hollywood Regency elegance filtered through Mexican Modernism. The table features a substantial gilt-brass frame with sweeping sculptural supports that terminate in stylized looped feet and tassel-like finials, lending a sense of movement and refinement.

A floating circular glass top rests above an antiqued mirrored lower tier, which adds depth and a subtle reflective shimmer, beautifully complementing the warm brass tones. The combination of materials and proportion reflects Pani's ability to merge architectural precision with opulent detail, hallmarks of his work for Mexico's elite interiors. This example just under five feet in circumference is quite large and takes presence in any room. This Arturo Pani gilt brass circular cocktail table would add a level of luxury design to any interior.
