| \$3,000 | <p>This sculpture by Claudio Nicoli portrays a cavalier on a horse with a staff. The unique patina creates the appearance of texture. The base is marble. The piece has been signed by Claudio Nicoli and numbered 3/6 on the rear of the horse.</p> <p>Born in San Giovanni in Persiceto in 1958, Claudio Nicoli started sculpting at a young age. Combining his passion for horses with his artistic skill, Nicoli prefers to work with terra cotta and bronze, producing sculptures and bas reliefs. His sculptures reflect a mix of surreal elements with classical themes. He has had a number of public commissions including sculptures and bas reliefs for The Municipality of Castenaso, The Franciscan Brothers of the La Verna Monastery, and the Santa Chiara Hospital in Trenton for which he was nationally recognized.
