



DAUM NANCY ART DECO VASE – RARE 1920S FRENCH GLASS WITH GILDED LEAVES

\$3,600	An impressive and rare 1920s Art Deco vase by Daum Nancy, France, standing at a commanding 65 cm (25.5 inches) in height. This elegant blown glass vase features a slender, flared neck and a broad base, richly hued in layered shades of amethyst and violet. The surface shimmers with painterly depth and includes four delicate, gilded leaf inclusions—applied during the hot-glass process—creating a luxurious contrast against the moody, mottled ground. The impressionistic treatment is both organic and refined, a hallmark of Daum’s decorative innovations during the early 20th century.
