



MICHAEL TAYLOR FAR EAST CONSOLE TABLE – BAKER, 1960S, MAHOGANY & ROSEWOOD

\$4,800 An exceptional and rare "Far East" console table designed by Michael Taylor for Baker Furniture, circa 1960s. Crafted in mahogany with a book matched Rosewood inlay, the piece exemplifies Taylor's refined vision of East-meets-West modernism. The geometric silhouette and stylized Asian-influenced apron are hallmarks of his iconic "Far East" collection, originally conceived during his celebrated collaboration with Baker. Distinctive ring hardware punctuates the floating upper rail, adding subtle contrast and sculptural interest.

This console table is increasingly scarce on the market, particularly in such excellent condition. With its architectural purity and timeless elegance, it embodies Taylor's talent for translating global design motifs into modern American luxury. A standout addition for collectors of mid-century design and /or those seeking a sophisticated statement piece with provenance and pedigree.
