Likely of Belgian or German origin circa 1960s, the tabletop is composed of intricate glass and clay tesserae in abstract geometric patterns, rendered in shimmering tones of ivory and metallic gold. The surface is bordered in solid brass and finished with a clear, brushed polish adding both durability and elegance. The architectural brass base adds lightness and structural rhythm, enhancing the table's refined yet artistic presence. A sophisticated centerpiece that beautifully bridges decorative art and modern design, this table evokes the work of designers like Berthold Müller or Willy Daro. A rare and collectible piece ideal for both residential and gallery environments.
