



MURANO BLACKAMOOR GLASS CANDLEHOLDER, ATTRIBUTED TO BAROVIER

\$1,150 This Murano Blackamoor glass candleholder is a striking example of Venetian artistry, attributed to Barovier & Toso, one of Murano's most renowned glassworks. Meticulously hand-blown, the figure features a dramatic black glass torso, elaborate ruffled collar and cuffs in pink and gold aventurine, and a swirling base that catches the light beautifully. The richly textured twisted glass cornucopia, serving as the candleholder, adds dimensionality and elegance to the piece. Murano Blackamoor glass candleholders were iconic decorative objects in the mid-20th century, valued for their craftsmanship and theatrical presence. This piece embodies the classic styling of Murano Blackamoor glass candleholder figures with its attention to proportion, vibrant colors, and luxurious gold-infused details. While unsigned, the quality and detailing are consistent with works by Barovier & Toso circa 1950s–1960s.
