



POLISHED STEEL AND MARBLE COCKTAIL TABLE, 1970S MINIMALIST DESIGN

This striking cocktail table offers a masterclass in refined minimalism, pairing the cool elegance of white marble with the industrial sophistication of polished steel. The rectangular marble top, subtly honed to retain a natural matte finish, floats above two substantial steel panel legs with a mirror-polished surface. The architectural silhouette is bold yet understated, allowing the materials to take center stage.

Though unsigned, the piece evokes the clean-lined sensibility of 1970s American and Italian modernism, with design echoes of Milo Baughman, Paul Evans, and the California Modern school. The recessed substructure gives the illusion of a floating top, adding lightness to the heavy materials and enhancing its visual tension.

Perfectly scaled for use as a cocktail or coffee table, it makes a strong statement in both residential and commercial settings—from gallery-like lofts to tailored living rooms. The table's minimalist language makes it an ideal pairing with modern, brutalist, or postmodern interiors.
