



## RESTORED JOHN STUART BURLLED WOOD CABINET OR DRESSER, SIGNED

**\$5,500** A striking example of 1970s American design, this vintage dresser or cabinet is crafted in beautifully figured burled wood and signed by John Stuart. The clean-lined rectangular form is elevated by the rich natural patterning of the wood grain, which brings visual depth and organic elegance to the minimalist silhouette.

Thoughtfully restored, the cabinet features two center doors that open to reveal adjustable storage, flanked on either side by three smoothly functioning drawers. The bookmatched burl veneer adds a layer of sophistication while the low plinth base ensures the profile remains grounded and modern. Ideal as a bedroom dresser, dining credenza, or entryway storage piece, this versatile cabinet exemplifies the refined craftsmanship and timeless appeal of mid-to-late 20th-century American furniture.

Signed on the interior, this piece is attributed to the celebrated New York design house John Stuart, known for its collaborations with top-tier furniture makers and designers of the era.
